

The Grenville Town Board met April 20, 2010 at the town hall with all members present at 7:00 p.m.

Chairman Robert Winters called the meeting to order & the pledge was said. The clerk proceeded to read the minutes from March. Richard Moore moved to accept and Greg Langer second. Approved.

George & Beverly Fink came before the board with an X Metropolitan Ag Preserve Agreement. Board approved and signed. This was in response to the new green acres classifications.

Randy Knutson came before the board for a subdivision agreement. He is refinancing & the lawyer said he should split house from the remaining acres. Approved & signed.

Scott & Lellan Norkunas, Craig Braun, Mike Deony, John Oppau attorney and David Hristendahl attorney came before the board. Trying to resolve the driveway for the Norkunas. There are several options (1) Easement (2) District Court decide (adverse possession). There seems to be conflicting issues as to where the driveway is (On whose property) need to have a survey done to determine this. Scott said he was told the
